- Supporting sexual health and HIV-related care as appropriate or demonstrating a willingness to develop competency in this area
- Delivering care across settings including the CHC, community locations, and home visits
- Collaborating with an interdisciplinary team to develop and implement care plans
- Participating in case conferences, quality improvement, and organizational initiatives
- Supporting continuity of care through coordination with hospital and community partners
