The candidate must be able to work varying work schedules, mainly 11:30am to 7:30pm Monday through Friday, and in multiple work locations.

- 3 to 5 years' experience in a community setting, or combined community, hospital and or public health, with at-risk youth and groups, and proficient in a range of treatment approaches
- Membership in good standing with CRPO or OCSWSSW required
- Master's degree or equivalent in a mental health discipline
- Experience/knowledge working within a trauma-informed framework
- Adept in family engagement strategies
- Experience working with interdisciplinary teams is an asset
